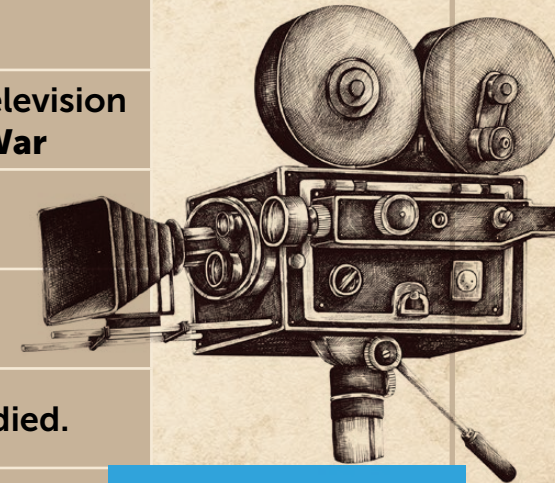


What happened when...?

Electricity	In 1933 1 in 3 houses in Britain had an electricity supply
Telephone	The public phone was first invented in 1912
Telegraph	This was used a lot in the First World War – a way of transferring messages over distance using wires.
Cars	Cars started being mass produced after World War 1, but they were too expensive for ordinary people.
Trams	Trams were popular in towns and cities in the UK in the 1920s and 1930s .
Buses	These became more reliable by the 1920s
Television	In 1926 John Logie Baird, a Scottish engineer, demonstrated the first television set in London. The TV became common after the Second World War
Films	The first 'talkie' film was shown in September 1928
Medicine	Alexander Fleming invented penicillin in 1928
Health	There was a big flu epidemic in Britain in 1918 . More than 200,000 died.
Health	The National Health Service came into being in 1948
Women's Rights	Women over 21 years old won the right to vote in elections for the first time in 1918
